The Return of all Children to School in September.

Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you are all well and keeping safe!

As we near the end of this academic year, I know you have been anxiously waiting to find out what the government proposals for starting school in September will be.

The announcements today included a list of measures the government have advised schools to implement in order for them to open the school to **ALL** pupils in September.

Since the lockdown the school has continually been open to children of key workers and various groups of children, including more recently identified year groups.

In September, the government expects ALL children to return to school.

Our intention is to attempt to implement these government guidelines so that we can fulfil our duties as educators and welcome our wonderful children back to our wonderful school.

Over the coming week we will be writing a very stringent risk assessment that will take into account the extensive government advice issued today and then creating a plan of action that will allow us to endeavour to open in September.

This risk assessment will be shared with you so that you know what will be in place for your child, and all children, when they return to school.

School will reopen, for ALL children, after the summer holidays on:-

Monday 7th September 2020.

We have been advised that schools should continue to implement ‘bubbles’ in some form, as well as encouraging staff and pupils, where they are able, to keep their distance from each other and avoiding touching.’

Additionally, the government has advised that ‘all schools should ensure that pupils can be taught a broad and balanced curriculum.’ Other measures set out in the guidance include:

- teachers to distance from each other and students where possible
- increasing the frequency of cleaning
- reducing the use of frequently shared items
- minimising contact in corridors

We will be working on the details of how we can make this happen and sharing those details with you before the end of the school year.

Remember, we will continue to have in mind, at all times, your child’s safety.
