Dear Parents / Carers

Over the Christmas break, it is extremely important that you continue to notify the school of any positive COVID-19 test results. You can do this by sending an email to admin.stockwell@hcat.org.uk or you can reply to one of the schools text messages if you do not have an email address.

[In addition to this, you must also contact Hull School Nursing Team on 01482 344301.](#)

For the first 6 days after teaching ends (from when school ends on Friday 18th December until 1.30pm on the 24th December), if a pupil tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school [and Hull School Nursing team will work together to](#) assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. Once we have been notified of the positive case, we will then be able to contact any other pupils that may have been in contact with the positive case prior to breaking up for the Christmas break.

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school do not need to be contacted. Parents and carers should follow the contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

If your child or a family member in your child's home, tests positive after Christmas, it is really important that you follow the self-isolation guidance. If the self-isolation period goes into the date we return to school in January, you must contact the school to let us know that your child (or family member) has tested positive.

We really appreciate your support with keeping our community safe.
