Dear Parents / Carers

We would like to remind parents to park safely, in the areas away from the entrances to the school. With the present situation, the school have had to put in measures to safeguard not only the pupils, but also the parents, in relation to COVID-19. By parking away from the main gates and utilising the streets in the area of the school, and walking a few metres helps tremendously to alleviate the congestion at peak times i.e. Morning drop offs and afternoon pick- ups.

We have had reports from some parents and school staff that some people are still insisting on stopping close to the school gates when the children are entering the school, sometimes leaving engines running whilst doing this. The Police will be monitoring this issue and will be informing our partners at Hull City council regarding this situation.

We have received concerns from the school of parents standing close together at the school gates and not wearing masks on the school grounds. Please keep to the Government guidelines and social distance as much as possible. It is advisable to wear masks outside but not mandatory. Schools do insist on wearing a mask if you are within their premises.

PLEASE THINK OF YOUR AND OTHER CHILDRENS SAFETY.

Hopefully restrictions will be lifted soon but we must all try to keep on doing the right thing to keep us all safe.
