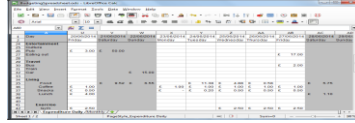

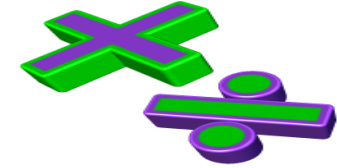

To observe that materials change state when they are heated or cooled.

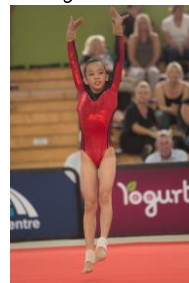
To research the temperature in degrees Celsius (°C) at which materials change state.
